-New Game/Roster Changes for 2015-effective Spring 2015

- 1. ALL game changes must be requested by the 2nd weekend of the season and the schedules will be frozen after that point.
 - 2. Only THREE games changes will be allowed during that time.
- 3. First game change is FREE (which includes tournament changes) Second game change is \$35 and Third game change is \$100.
- 4. All game changes must be communicated by email with the opposing team and the FINAL email chain must be sent to the CPYSL office with the game request.
- 5. No TRANSFERS/SECONDARIES will be allowed after the second weekend of the season.
- 6. Only brand new primary players will be allowed and hardship cases will be reviewed by the board.
- 7. During the first two weeks of the season, game and roster changes must be submitted no later than 4 days before the game match.
- 8. <u>MOST</u> of U9/U10 games will be played on SATURDAY AM and U11/U12 will be played on SATURDAY PM...this is to help provide referees for the games.
- 9. GAME CARDS: please mail them. Emailing takes time, paper, and ink to print. There will be a \$5 fee for each one needing to be printed by email.

1. U13/U14 games will be moved to SUNDAYS after 1pm.
